A thorough literature review on the potential for airborne spread of COVID-19 in healthcare facilities will accompany the assessment and be submitted for publication. The student(s) will help assess/identify high-risk COVID-19 exposure areas, particularly in hospitals and walk-in clinics in the Okanagan. Work completed during this project will be timely in this global pandemic and help advocate for further research on the transmission of airborne diseases and changes to policy in healthcare settings.
