The Executive Vice Dean welcomed members to the first meeting under the renewed Terms of the Reference of the Faculty of Medicine Faculty Executive Committee.

The Dean's report was reviewed, as circulated.

5.0. UBC JAMES HOGG RESEARCH CENTRE (JHRC) EXTERNAL REVIEW AND RESPONSE – DR. K. WALLEY

The slide deck was reviewed as presented. The JHRC is a hospital embedded translational lab. In the past 5 years, the Centre has been very high performing with respect to the number of publications, calibre of research, and field-weighted citation impact. An overview of the Centre's grant success in the current year was provided. Response to recommendations from the external review was reviewed as presented.

In the subsequent Q&A, it was clarified that the infrastructure funding flows from PHCRI and comes from Vancouver Coastal Health. Areas of focus going forward include: 1. Programmatic development/expansion, 2. Leveraging existing opportunities in funding and research, and 3. Formulating a clearer, more unified vision.

The UBC policy for appropriate follow up and closing of the loop on external reviews was briefly discussed. The JHRC annual report may be helpful for tracking progress on existing recommendations.
