If a candidate is being reviewed for both promotion and tenure, the vote for promotion always occurs first.

If a letter of reference is used from the candidate's application package, a follow-up request to ensure that they meet the criteria for appointment is also usually required (if the referee does not make an explicit statement regarding the appointment at X rank or with tenure).
