



**INFORMATION NOTE:** 2019/20 Housing Loan Interest Distribution

**PREPARED FOR:** FoM Department Heads, School and Centre Directors

**ISSUE:** **Distribution of Housing Loan Interest Benefit Charges to Departments**

**BACKGROUND:**

Full-time faculty members at UBC are eligible to apply for the UBC Faculty Home Ownership Program to assist with the purchase of their principal home in Metro Vancouver.

Under the program there are two options:

1. Down Payment Assistance: This provides a lump sum forgivable interest-free loan of up to \$50,000 for a five-year period. The mortgage interest assistance program has been discontinued, but will remain in effect for those who began the program between 2013 and 2016.
2. Prescribed interest rate loan program: This provides faculty members a one-time loan, with annual interest payments. The entire loan is due 15 years after activation.

In most cases, the cost of the benefit is covered 50% by UBC Treasury and 50% by the department.

UBC Treasury calculates the department's housing loan charge and transfers the cost to the Faculty (Peoplesoft speedchart KATE/Workday worktag PM007816) on an annual basis. At year-end, these costs are then distributed by the Faculty to the appropriate departments. On March 31, 2020, \$180,146 of housing loan charges were distributed to the departments (Peoplesoft JID 0012094764 & JID 0012104692).
