

**INFORMATION NOTE:** Distribution of incremental tuition revenue

**PREPARED FOR:** FoM Department Heads, School and Centre Directors

ISSUE: Allocation of incremental tuition income for FY 2012-13

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Faculty of Medicine receives an annual incremental increase and/or decrease of tuition from the UBC Budget office as a part of the GPO funding model. This represents changes in tuition due to changes in enrolment over the previous year. The base tuition is already included in each departmental GPO allocation, and only the incremental increase and/or decreases remain to be distributed.

#### **ANALYSIS:**

- The fiscal year 2011-12 is taken as the base year. The difference between tuition revenue in 2012-13 and the base year 2011-12 is the increment to be distributed in 2013-14.
- The summer tuition base allocation is done through annual transfers. Departments receiving earned revenue will receive the historical base amount plus/minus the increment from 2011-12 as a recurring transfer. All future incremental revenue will be managed through the incremental tuition allocation method.
- A decrease in tuition of less than \$10,000 will be absorbed by the Dean's Office so that the year over year impact is limited.
- The incremental revenue will be distributed as 75% for the earning Department and 25% for the Faculty, excluding Expansion-related tuition increases. The portion for the Faculty is retained to offset decreases in tuition absorbed, and to fund Faculty level distributions such as salary increases, when possible. In this distribution, the offset for decreases and the distribution to cover salary increases is greater than the Faculty portion earned. See Appendix A.
- \$250,000 of incremental tuition revenue was committed to fund the salary increases for Fiscal 13 (July 2012 increases applied in spring 2013). This allocation was in addition to \$244,000 from turn over savings.
- The current analysis does not include incremental revenue from CFIS and CLTL transfers, which remains to be calculated.

#### **NEXT STEPS:**

• Distribute 75% of incremental tuition revenue to each department in relation to earnings as per Appendix D.
